Madam the Presidente, Misters the Presidents

Former senior French official, current president of an association, Agirlocal, I have no financial interest in the idea of providing an answer to one of the most critical situations experienced in winter by ukrainians which logment has been devastated: in this case, shelter in temporary accommodation well insulated, with components that can be reused when the time comes in permanent housing.

Costly to destroy with missiles, - overpriced compared to the target-, the answer is based on a solution built from recycled cardboard, apparently fragile, in reality robust, which has passed all the tests in France and meets the necessary standards: bearing capacity, humidity, fire resistance, thermal insulation in particular.

This last criterion is key: the temperature felt is the average of the temperature measured by the thermometer and that of the walls and ceilings. Cardboard is particularly interesting both for thermal insulation and for the half-day thermal phase shift it provides: the little heat stored during the day is released at night.

Healthy product, light, easy to handle and transport, removable and reusable, the product allows the construction of an alveole of 10 to 20 m2 (without equipment or furniture in a first time to built more and more quickly), manufactured in factories and whose assembly requires only one single day on site. The components are reusable when the time comes to build individual or collective housing but also (as soon as possible) schools or hospitals.

It is this possibility of moving from the alveole to housing that can make it possible to spend the winter in better conditions while creating the beginnings of ecological reconstruction of housing, bearing hope for Ukrainians, exemplary for Europeans and those who want to be. The war on civilians triggers a political but also a civil response for civilians.

The deployment of such a solution requires exceptional mobilization, on your part and several contributing actors, outlined in the attached note. It could lead to a first delivery, symbolic, for Christmas.
